

CHECKLIST FOR Ph.D. PROGRAMME BASED ON Ph.D. REGULATIONS

Eligibility Criteria for Ph.D. admission:

1. For full time scholars minimum eligibility:
 - (a) Masters Degree in relevant discipline with 55% marks in aggregate.
 - (b) Selection through entrance test and/or interview. **At the time of interview, doctoral candidates are expected to discuss their research interest/area.** Applicants who have valid course Score of high level in any of the relevant National Eligibility Test like GATE/NET of UGC/CSIR/SLET of the State, **may be given preference as decided by the Dean of the concerned faculty.**
2. For sponsored scholars, **attached full time to Research Projects**
 - (a) Masters Degree in relevant discipline with 55% marks in aggregate.
 - (b) These candidate must have served with organization for minimum of 2 years on a full time basis.
 - (c) Selection Through written test and/or interview. **At the time of interview, doctoral candidates are expected to discuss their research interest/area.**

Application for Admission:

1. Applications will be invited from candidates by issue of advertisement or circular or public notice through media or internet or in any other manner. **(mentioning the number of seats for M Phil / Ph.D Course, Department wise in the faculty) Reservation in Admission to be made available as per, "Govt. Norms".**
2. A candidate seeking Admission to a Ph.D. programme must apply to the **Head of concerned Department of the University on the prescribed form for appearing at the entrance test with all the required documents / certificates.**
3. Admission to the Ph.D. programmes will be made on the basis of interview, subsequent to entrance test, conducted by the **Department Research Committee (DRC)**
4. Admission to Ph.D. program will be subject to vacancy being available in the relevant specializations.
5. **After having been admitted, each M.Phil/Ph.D student shall be required to undertake course work for a minimum period of one semester, as a Resident Research Scholar. The course work shall be treated as pre M.Phil/Ph.D preparation and will include a course on research methodology, quantitative methods and computer applications. It may also involve reviewing of published research in the relevant field. Student qualifying at this course will proceed further with the writing of the dissertation.**
6. M.Phil and Ph.D programmes shall not be conducted through distance education mode.

FEE:

1. Fees will be charged as fixed by the fee fixation committee of the University from time to time.
2. However the candidate may have to pay the additional charges i.e. on account of expenditure in excess of amount, approved by DRC or provided by sponsoring agency for carrying out instrumentation, experimentation and such related activity(ies) in relation to the research.
3. Student will not be entitled to any TA/DA on account of expenditure incurred on activities related to research.
